New Applicant: Medical (MD) / Graduate Checklist



This checklist is intended to assist you in completing the Scholarship Foundation of Santa Barbara **General Scholarship Program Application** as a **New Applicant: Medical (MD)/Graduate Applicant**. For help determining your intended program of application or applicant status, refer to our [General Eligibility Requirements](#) and [Determine Applicant Status](#) worksheets.

Required Documents for Application

This checklist does not include tasks within the application, just supplemental documents. Be sure to complete ALL tasks required for your scholarship program in order to submit your application.

(2) Letters of Recommendation

Recommendations must be submitted directly by your recommenders via FluidReview, the online Scholarship Foundation application platform. You will complete a task which asks for your recommenders' names and email addresses. Upon completing the task, your recommenders will receive an email with follow-up instructions.

- One letter *must* be academic; the second can be academic, extracurricular, employer, or volunteer service-related
- Your recommender cannot be related to you
- No form is required – recommenders should use their own format
- **No hard copies will be accepted**

Upload High School Transcripts

- Unofficial transcripts are acceptable
- Transcript must include graduation date and GPA
- Applicants who **attended multiple high schools** must provide transcripts from all institutions not listed on your 12th grade transcript

Upload College Transcripts - All Post-Secondary

- This includes transcripts from ALL undergraduate and postgraduate work
- Unofficial transcripts are acceptable
- Transcript must show graded work and cumulative GPA after Fall 2016, if enrolled

OPTIONAL - All Medical/Graduate Placement Scores

You may submit any medical/graduate placement test scores to strengthen your application. For example: CBEST, DAT, GMAT, GRE, LSAT, MCAT, OAT, PCAT.

- Unofficial reports are acceptable
- Official scores cannot be mailed to the Scholarship Foundation

2017-2018 Student Aid Report (SAR)

Refer to our RESOURCES section for instructions on obtaining your SAR.

- **This is the only document which is not due by the deadline of January 15, 2017**
- Your SAR must be submitted via your online Scholarship Foundation Application account no later than **March 8, 2017**

Select applicants will be invited for a personal interview during the months of February and March. Note that early interviews may be available, but *only* to students who have completed their application in its entirety (with the exception of the Student Aid Report).
