APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Have attended at least four of the six years between grades 7-12 at a Southern Santa Barbara County* school, AND graduate or receiving a G.E.D. from a Southern Santa Barbara County High School.
2. Be a current high school senior planning to major in art or an art-related field and enroll full time at a Title IV-approved** community college, university, vocational school in the upcoming academic year.
3. Be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, or AB 540 eligible
4. Art scholarship recipients will be selected from an exhibit of their art portfolio during a judged competition in January

*Southern Santa Barbara County includes Goleta, Santa Barbara, and Carpinteria.

PROGRAM INFORMATION:

The Scholarship Foundation of Santa Barbara's Annual Art Competition Scholarship is a program for the *traditional* fine arts, including painting, drawing, sketching, photography, design, and furniture, and sculpture. We cannot accept films, video, 100% computer-generated/digital art, or any type of performance art. **Financial need is not required.**

A select number of applicants will receive an email invite in December 2016 to participate in the Art Judging Competition in January 2017. Selected applicants must arrange for their portfolio to be delivered and picked up on the specified date at the Ridley-Tree Art Education Center, 1600 Santa Barbara Street. Portfolios will be limited to four pieces or less. You will be required to provide the date each piece was created. The Scholarship Foundation is not responsible for unclaimed portfolios.

Winners of the Art Scholarship Competition are selected from the judged group only. All scholarship winners are required to attend the Art Scholarship Reception in January 2017 to display the portfolio pieces entered in the competition.
