APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Have attended at least four of the six years between grades 7-12 at a Southern Santa Barbara County* school, and graduate or in addition to graduating or receiving G.E.D. from a Southern Santa Barbara County High School.
2. Be a current high school senior planning to enroll full time at a Title IV-approved** community college, university, vocational school in the upcoming academic year.
3. Demonstrate high achievement (e.g., above a 4.2 weighted GPA and above-average SAT scores) by providing two academic letters of recommendation, SAT/ACT scores, and a high school transcript.
4. Be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, or AB 540 eligible

*Southern Santa Barbara County includes Goleta, Santa Barbara, and Carpinteria.

**Title IV approval refers to the U.S. Department of Education's guidelines on which institutions are eligible to receive financial aid, including international campuses. Visit <https://fafsa.ed.gov/FAFSA/app/schoolSearch> to search for your institution.

PROGRAM INFORMATION:

The Scholarship Foundation of Santa Barbara's Honors Scholarship Program is a competitive, rigorous competition for students who demonstrate a very high level of academic achievement and motivation. Financial need is not considered.

After applications are evaluated, a select number of applicants will be invited to have a personal interview at the Scholarship Foundation office. Selected applicants will be contacted by email during December 2016.
